(viii) PLACEMENT CELL

- Special Placement Training was given to the students
- It trains the students in communication; logical reasoning and subjects’ specialization so far has procured 184 placements, which is 67% of the eligible students.
- The students are placed in the companies, TCS, Infosys, CTS, Varizon, Sundaram Finance, AGS Health, Homecredit, Amazon, Accenture, HCL, Pactron and Jaro education.
- The highest package offered for an undergraduate student is 4.4. lakh per annum. 100 % placement was achieved in the Department of Catering Science and Hotel Management.

(ix) EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

- NCC, NSS, YRC and WBDC build a strong bond between students and society.
- In November, our NCC and NSS volunteers visited the flood affected slums in Chennai and rendered the first-hand timely help. It was highly appreciated by the Management, public and press. 75 valiant students, from NSS and NCC, marched towards Chennai with 17 tonnes of food and other required materials and they distributed the materials in person to the flood victims.
- Not only on stage, but off stage too our students are real champions. ACC Cement and C4TN’s **The Real Heroes Award**, presented to our students for their help in packing and shifting the flood relief materials is another proven example of our students’ service to the society.
- Commissioner’s direct supervision and high appreciation were notable. The contribution of NSS volunteers in people mobilization for Guinness World Record - Organ Donation Programme is remarkable.
- The NSS volunteers tirelessly visited more than forty colleges and many number of public places to motivate the students and public through skits.

- Mr. P. Keerthivasan of BBA CA brought laurel to the college by participating in the 67<sup>th</sup> Republic Day Parade from NSS wing. Keerthivasan is the only student who represented Bharathiar University in this parade. To commemorate Keerthivasan's contribution to the society, Bharathiar University and Vivekanandar, Uyar Aaivu Kalvi Maiyam awarded him 'Swami Vivekananda Elignar Sadanaiyalar Virudu' for being the Best Student of the Year
- From NCC, Mr. Joe Moses of II B.Sc. Electronics, in the IGC Camp of RD Parade, won gold medal in Contingent Drill.
- Mr Sekar won the title "Renowned Shooter" in the 50 Mts Small Bore Rifle and 300 Mts Big Bore Rifle in the 59<sup>th</sup> National Shooting Championship Competition. He also won Silver Medal in G.V. Maulankar Shooting Competition held at New Delhi.
- Mr. G.C. Suryaprakash, III BSc CS&HM was selected for SSB training capsule at Kamptee, Maharastra in April 2016.
- About 100+ prizes were bagged by our students in various inter-collegiate competitions, both in technical and fine arts.
- The college celebrated all the traditional festival days like Onam, Christmas and Pongal.
- We were a part of Kovai Vizha 2016. A Cookery Competition and an awareness programme on "Food for Healthy Living" were conducted for the public by the Department of Catering Science and Hotel Management.
- Two other cookery competitions were conducted in collaboration with The Hindu and Women's Club of Coimbatore City.
