II ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

- Meetings of the Board of Studies for all the majors were held on 3rd May 2017.

- The Curriculum and Syllabi under Regulations 2016 is designed keeping in mind the Outcome Based Education (OBE) and Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The course content of each course shall be fixed in accordance with the Program Educational Objectives (PEOs), Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs). The CBCS enables the students to earn credits across programmes and provides flexibility for slow and fast learners in registering the required number of credits in a semester.
